

PADRON RENEWAL - RE-REGISTRATION

In response to information received from Nueva Javea, I asked Councillor Doris Courcelles to confirm the rules on Padron renewal. Below is her reply:

*European residents and Swiss citizens have to renew their "Padron" registration every 5 years and non-community residents every 2 years. But - DON'T PANIC. The citizens who have to renew it will receive a notification. If they don't trust their postman....., they can go to the register office which is now in Carrer d'Avall (the technical office) and the good news is that, on the **25th, Thursday**, the Town hall (I would say "my department" if I was not so modest!) has decided to open the "Santa Ana" chapel, next door. A nice lady who speaks various languages will be there for those who have to renew.*

People who are interested must not forget to present an official document, passport or identity card that shows the name and the photograph or a copy of their last "padrón" certificate. I hope that these explanations will help your members.....

This street runs parallel to the Calle Mayor, behind the Library.
