Reading Scheme



A new reading scheme has been set up in Spain to encourage people to take more interest in reading. At the moment there are 2 places in Javea old town where you can leave a book and pick one up – in front of the Post Office and also in the indoor market. Most of the books are in the Spanish language but there are some in the English language too.

Before leaving a book and picking one up, you must first take the book you are leaving to be stamped at the library in the old town.

Whilst informing members of this new scheme we would remind members that you can borrow English language books free of charge from the international section of the Library in the Old Town (third floor). The English section is open from 10.00-12.00 am on Tuesday and Saturday mornings. You can borrow as many books as you want for 3 weeks. There are shelves containing hundreds of books that have all been donated.
